2. Position Summary

This position will be preferably based on site (full-time) in order to provide the project management for the design, procurement, build and commissioning stages of a steam network across the PlasChem Park. This includes the management of the design, including coordination in order to obtain the needed authorization, the supervision of procurement, onsite construction management, project coordination and management, plant check out and start-up and other assignments as may be designated by management.

3. Key Responsibilities

- Represent Veolia on a permanent basis, ensure that the strategy of the Group is implemented and its interests protected; in particular, ensure that the project is delivered in a timely manner and within budget
- Ensure that HSE requirements are properly implemented and controlled
- Manage the design, review & comment design documents issued by Consultants and/or Contractors to make sure they meet company standards
- Manage and supervise the project's consultants during the design phase to review and approve the final design package prior to issuing it for tendering.
- Directly manage and supervise the contractors/suppliers on a daily basis and structure their tasks to ensure that the project objectives are met. Provide directions to contractors and/or suppliers to ensure resolution of technical issues during construction.
- Management and coordination with local stakeholders in order to necessary permits and authorizations
- Develop a plan to maintain quality and prevent deficiencies through all project phases
- Define and maintain KPIs relative to the design, procurement, construction and commissioning activities
- In charge of reporting the progress on works and on schedule, present forecast and also propose mitigation actions when suitable
- Remain knowledgeable of the contract documents, assist the contract manager for claims & variations
- Coordination with Veolia Tahwil project team
- Coordination with Veolai Middle East HQ I needed and liaise with the Group experts
- Organize daily inspections of ongoing work, may reject work not meeting construction standards set in the contract documents
- Review and approve progress payments to the Contractors/Suppliers
- Provide field construction supervision and coordination between several contractors, making sure that on site activities meet required specifications and construction drawings
- Assist the procurement team in negotiating installation contracts, evaluate and recommend potential contractors/suppliers
- Prepare REX for the benefit of the Group
- Revise and update construction and safety manuals to keep them in line with regulations
- Perform other duties as assigned

4. Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in an engineering field is required
- Four years of engineering and/or project/design management experience is required
- Project Management Consultant (PMC) experience is a plus
- Experience of heavy industrial machinery & utility installation is a plus
- Experience in mechanical/piping networks is mandatory
