

The challenge

Ensure public service of drinking water in urban and semi-urban, efficient and quality and contribute to the socio-economic development; Niger and in particular the financial stability of the sector.

The main objectives of the SEEN are:

- Increase the number of people with access to safe drinking water while participating in the implementation of a social policy of access to safe drinking water facility with social connections and standpipes.
- Improve network performance, reliable quality of the produced water and become a customer reference management
- Develop a Skills Development Plan for all employees.

Veolia's solution

Founded in 2001, the operating company of the Waters of Niger (SEEN) is present on the entire territory across 54 centers. It is responsible for the operation of public water service from production to distribution. Company of reference in the sub region for the quality of the water it provides, SEEN ensures continuity in the distribution of drinking water with more than 630 employees. In 2013, there were 168,000 customers SEEN more than 2.3 million inhabitants served.
