Business Arising

LM – asked about recording complaints on the Veolia website. HG has procedures on recording such information. When a complaint is lodged with Veolia, there is a licence requirement to respond and submit a report within 24 hours to the EPA. HG unsure what the EPA do with the information and if they make the reports public.

LM – concerned that the document on Procedure on non conforming waste from regional areas is too general and not specific to Woodlawn. JH will review document.

Operational Update

Waste update – January to May – 209,831 tonnes
Electrical Generation – 12,414MWh

Odour Management

HG will be attending TADPAI meeting on Monday 16 June to co ordinate Odour Diaries distribution and training date.

CR asked about an electronic version, as he has been recording information into an excel spreadsheet over time, which could be provided to the Odour Unit

Woodlawn Mechanical Biological Treatment Facility (MBT)

Construction has been awarded to LIPMAN and will begin in about 8 weeks.

The Woodlawn MBT Facility is set to start operating early 2016.

Banksmeadow Transfer Terminal, approval process is well underway, with the EIS already reviewed for public comment .

Other Matters

Woodlawn Aquaculture Facility – set to sell first batch of live fish next week

HG to clarify with Christine Hodgkiss about the approval to operate on public holidays and weekends. The licence states this is permitted, however the consent conditions state differently

Bio-solids trial by Transpacific in paddock to the west of the mine site. Delivering around 1600t has stated

10 year anniversary in September, will be looking for feedback from TADPAI and Local community at various options

LM – Clarification of 2nd Council representative. Larry was informed from council election in Sept 2013 that LM was 1 of the 2 reps, and Cr M O'Neill was the other rep with Cr R Saville as a reserve in Cr O'Neill's absence. HG had letter from GMC dated 2012 that the 2 reps were Cr O'Neill and Cr Saville.

- HG will write to council to seek clarification with reference to the charter and letter 2012 also reference consent conditions and waste agreement. LM under the original conditions is the licence supervisor
