Business Arising

Cr O'Neill thanked Veolia for the 10 year celebration dinner and a positive for staff and community.

LM – Conforming Waste document, HG will send to L Meng, with amendment concerning guidelines on Local waste. Noting Host fees are not separate and GMC to clarify with Veolia.

Local Waste

On Monday 2 March took first load from Tarago Waste depot of 2.24 tonnes
This will continue every Monday, equalling around 4 tonnes per week

Odour Management

Veolia are looking to invest \$2m on a program that will maintain effective leachate treatment, and improve gas capture and less emissions.

Cid Riley stated that he and other residents had notice a reduction in the odour detected in recent months. At the recent TADPAI meeting they sent a positive feedback letter to the EPA also commenting in their monthly news article for the Tarago Times.

We have had 3 compliants since last meeting.

Woodlawn Mechanical Biological Treatment Facility (MBT)

Expected approval from the DoP will be before end of March 2015. Construction hasn't started but we have received on site equipment stored in 40' Containers. At the end of month the drums will arrive. They are wide loads and follow the RMS route through Goulburn, in the early morning under escort.

Cr O'Neill concerned about weight and route, due to the damage to the roads that was caused by wind towers coming through town.

HG to follow up with Simon Zadow and transport company about the timing, weights and route.

Heron Resources – Woodlawn Mine

Heath Sandercock wrote to each committee members requesting their future involvement on Heron Consultative Committee. Cr Saville received this letter and advised HS to write to Goulburn Mulwaree Council with this request.

Other Matters

Cr Saville requested HG to send him, Veolia's calculations on Tarago waste

HG advised that to improve access and space within the Tarago Tip site, Veolia will be considering an invest in a walkway for residences to empty their waste directly into Bins. We have 2 there at the moment and looking at a 3rd bin. Then trucks can reverse easily and take bins away.
