PLASTIC



All clear and coloured plastic bottles; plastic pots, trays (plastic takeaway trays; fruit/veg trays), chocolate and biscuit tubs and trays, other clear plastic packaging.)

ALUMINUM



Aluminum, steel and tin, drinks cans, food tins, biscuit/chocolate tins and their lids, empty aerosols, clean foil.

PAPER



All clean paper (newspapers, magazines, brochures and catalogues, white paper, shredded paper, telephone directories, leaflets, flyers, envelopes.)
All cardboard (cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard greetings cards without glitter.)

NO, DON'T GO RECYCLING !



Plastic bags film or wrapping eg bread bags and bubble wrap, Polystyrene cups, trays and protective packaging.
Crisp and sweet wrappers, plastic toys, medicine blister packs, toothpaste tubes.



Laminated foil coffee pouches, crisp packets and sweet wrappers, general kitchenware. Any other metal items.



Wet or dirty paper including napkins, tissues, kitchen roll and wallpaper. cards or wrapping paper with glitter, takeaway coffee cups, wrapping paper. Wet or dirty cardboard food contaminated cardboard ie pizza.
